Time schedule: Sun 5/10 start at Spier 8h00, return at 18h00



Start the day at Blaaubergstrand Beach with a walk through the various vegetation types of the conservation area and an introduction to the local biodiversity values and threats in the context of the City of Cape Town Biodiversity Network. Then climb up to the canon on top of Tygerberg hill in the Nature Reserve for a grand view of Cape Town, an introduction to the endangered renosterveld and local BIOTA AFRICA research on fragmentation effects and restoration. End the day with a relaxed wine-tasting at De Grendel, one of the Biodiversity and Wine Farms and proud of their negative Carbon footprint.
